And don't let this change confuse you; we will still refer to our staff members who work closely with our clients and employees as "PWAC staff"!

ANNOUNCEMENT!

In this new year, we are now referring to the individuals enrolled in our programs as "clients" and "employees."



Our employees regularly work for our Progressive Production Services subbusiness to complete production jobs for Cook Medical in Vandergrift, PA. PWAC has referred to the adults with disabilities in our programs as "clients" and "trainees" for many years.

Many of our individuals, previously referred to as "trainees," complete work projects as part of their training and skills development within their programs.

- They earn wages for the work they complete and are paid by
- They have long been referred to as "trainees" to distinguish them from "clients"

"Clients" are individuals enrolled at PWAC who do NOT work to earn wages as part of their training.

To properly acknowledge these individuals who represent PWAC's programs and businesses through their work, we will now be referring to them as our "employees" (rather than "trainees").

We are excited for this change! To us, it signifies an ongoing respect for those we serve and a desire to acknowledge their roles and accomplishments within our agency.


